

INCOME SURVEY FORM 2022-2023

The private school your child attends would like to participate in a program under The Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). The program provides supplementary instruction to students who are educationally disadvantaged and failing or most at risk of failing.

The purpose of this survey is to determine the number of children who would qualify for free or reduced-price lunches through the U.S. Department of Agriculture. This information is confidential and it is not necessary to provide student names. The data collected will be used to determine the amount of funds that might be available to provide supplementary educational services to your eligible non-public school students.

CURRENT INCOME = The amount of income each household member received last month, before taxes or anything else is taken out, and where it came from, such as earnings, welfare, pensions, and other income.

A HOUSEHOLD OF ONE = means a child who is his or her sole support. Foster children are one-member households only if the welfare or the placement agency maintains legal responsibility for the child.

HOUSEHOLD = is synonymous with family and means a group of related or unrelated individuals who are not residents of an institution of boarding house, but who are living as one economic unit sharing housing and all significant income and expenses.
